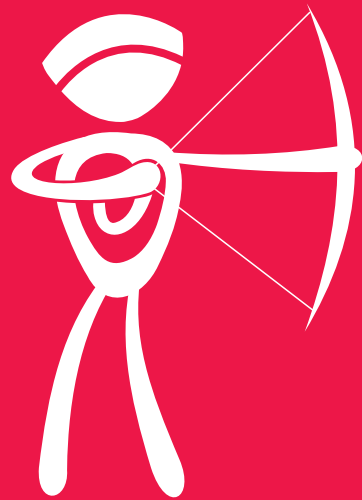

COMPETITION FORMAT

Team elimination for both recurve and composed bow will take place as a simple elimination format, in which the winner of a game goes on and the loser is eliminated. Each composed bow game will be a series of 24 arrows for same-sex teams and 16 arrows for missed teams. The recurve bow games will be developed with a set format. The first team that reaches or surpasses 5 points in the set will be the winner of the game.

If, point addition after 24 arrows (or 16 arrows for mixed teams) in compound bow is tied; and at 4 set points in recurve bow, a series of 3 arrows will be shot (2 for missed teams). The time allotted to a tie-breaker is 1 minute for same-sex teams and 40 seconds for missed teams. The team with the highest result in the addition of points for the shot arrows will win. If a tie in point addition occurs, the game will be called by the arrow closest to the center of the bull's-eye for each team in the tie-breaker round.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

In accordance to the quota set by CACSO, the Archery competition will have a maximum of **100** athletes, 44 women and 56 men distributed as follows:

Women's recurve bow, 24; men's recurve bow, 28; women's compound bow, 20; men's compound bow, 28; leading to a total of 100.

WORLD ARCHERY AMERICAS has set athlete distribution based on participation numbers per category in the past two editions of the Central American and Caribbean Games as well as the two most recent Pan American Championships.

Important Specifications:

Each NOC may register a maximum of 3 athletes per category and gender, as long as the qualification criteria for Archery for the XXII Central American and Caribbean Games, Veracruz 2014 are fulfilled

VERACRUZ 2014 QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

Two Qualification Tournaments will take place:

a) Qualification Tournament #1:

World Cup, Medellin, Colombia, July 15 - 21, 2013 (An elimination round took place for teams as well as individuals in each category independently with the countries in the region during the World Cup).

b) Qualification Tournament # 2:

It will take place May 27th to June 2nd, 2014, in Guatemala, Guatemala.

This tournament will allow those countries with less than 3 classified archers to qualify for a slot. The archers that have already earned slots for their countries in the first classification tournament will not be able to compete for new slots in the second classification tournament.

c) In the case of both qualification tournaments, the slots earned are for the country, not necessarily for the winning archers.



d) Team Event Qualification for the Games.

1. This qualification system guarantees a minimum of 5 countries per team event. The number of teams can grow with countries that have 3 individual archers qualify in a category among both qualification tournaments. That is, a team can be made up of 2 individual qualified archers in Tournament #1, and one individual archer in Tournament #2.

2. The competition for mixed teams in both recurve and compound bows will include all countries that have at least one male competitor and one female competitor qualified in the same bow category.

e) National Archery federations must confirm their slots used, in writing, to World Archery Americas by July **15th, 2014** at the latest. In case of withdrawal or vacancies, the available slots will be distributed among the countries that earned the positions immediately beneath the qualified countries in the Qualification Tournament as a first criteria. As a second criteria, World Archery Americas will define the countries that will fill the remaining vacancies.

f) World Archery Americas shall inform the Organizing Committee of the decision made about the substitute countries, in writing, no later than **July 30th, 2014**. This measure is taken so the NOCs are able to respect the dates stipulated by CACSO for entries by name and number.

Qualification system approval

The qualification system was approved by majority by the member countries of World Archery Americas in the Central American and Caribbean region on September 1st, 2012.



TECHNICAL MEETING

- The Technical Meeting will take place on **Sunday, November 16th** at the USBI at a time to be confirmed.
- Up to two representatives from each NOC will be able to assist this Technical Meeting.
- The invitation card for the Technical Meeting will be available to the Heads of Team at the Sports Information Center at the Central American and Caribbean Village in Xalapa upon their arrival.
- The Technical Delegate and the Organizing Committee's Competition Manager for Archery will preside the meeting, which shall take place in Spanish and English.

TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

Judges and officials will be designated by the Judges Commission which is part of the Pan American Confederation in November 2013.

PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Protests and appeals will be resolved in accordance to what is described in the International Federation's rules and regulations. There will be an appeals jury made up of 3 people what will decide on the appeals presented. The jury will be presided by the Technical Delegate and will include two others who will also be named in November 2013. Appeals must be presented in writing to the Head of Judges in a form that will be given to every country's delegate at the Technical Meeting.



DRAW

Shooting positions will be drawn by the Technical Delegate two days before official practice.

AUTHORIZED SPORTS EQUIPMENT

The technical equipment that will be used is described in the World Archery Rules and Regulations.

Archer's equipment inspection will take place Monday, November 17th, 2014 at 9:30 am at the USBI.

MEDAL CEREMONIES

Medal ceremonies will take place according to CACSO's General Regulations, Chapter XIII.

Individual Events:

- First place: Gold medal and diploma
- Second place: Silver medal and diploma
- Third place: Bronze medal and diploma

Team Events:

- First place: A diploma for the team and a gold medal and diploma for each athlete
- Second place: A diploma for the team and a silver medal and diploma for each athlete
- Third place: A diploma for the team and a bronze medal and diploma for each athlete



COMPETITION VENUE

The Archery competition will take place at the USBI, which can be found at Av. De las Culturas Veracruzanas, No. 1, Zona Universitaria, Col. Zapata, Xalapa, Ver.
