## COMPETITORS' AGES

The competitors of the Track, Road and Mountain Bike events must be **eighteen (18)** years old in 2014. BMX competitors must be **seventeen (17)** years old in 2014.



## VERACRUZ 2014 QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

a) Mexico, as host country is qualified with two (2) participants in each Cycling event in the XXII Central American and Caribbean Games Veracruz 2014, without exceeding the maximum limit of athletes per NOC.

b) The other countries must participate in the following qualifying events:

c) Each NOC must confirm participation in qualified events to the Pan American Cycling Confederation. This will allow the distribution of empty slots to other NOCS if they no longer wish to compete.

This information must be submitted to the Pan American Cycling Confederation's e-mail [panaci@enet.cu](mailto:panaci@enet.cu) and to the Organizing Committee before the deadline for entries.

d) In case an NOC resigns to the obtained slot, the Technical committee of the Pan American Cycling Confederation will be in charge of determining the NOC to which that slot will be assigned to.

e) The vacancies to be distributed in each event will be announced by COPACI before **August 31st, 2012**.

f) Vacancies are assigned to the country, not to the athlete that obtains them.

### Qualification system approval

This qualification system was approved by COPACI on October 14th, 2012.



## TECHNICAL MEETINGS

- The Technical Meeting for Mountain Bike will take place on **Friday November 14th, 2014** at the Central American and Caribbean Village in Xalapa at a time to be confirmed.
- The Technical Meeting for Road and Track Cycling will take place on **Saturday November 15th, 2014** at the Central American and Caribbean Village in Xalapa at a time to be confirmed.
- The Technical Meeting for Road and Track Cycling will take place on **Friday November 21st, 2014** at the Central American and Caribbean Village in Xalapa at a time to be confirmed.
- Up to 2 NOC representatives may attend the technical meetings.
- The invitation card for the Technical Meeting will be available to the Heads of Team at the Sports Information Center at the Central American and Caribbean Village upon their arrival.
- The Technical Delegate and the President of the Panel of Commissaires will preside the meetings, which will be in Spanish with simultaneous translation to English.



## TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

The International Cycling Union will designate the President of the Panel of Commissaires.

The Pan American Cycling Confederation will designate the Technical Delegate for Track, Road, BMX and Mountain Cycling as well as the members of the Jury of Commissaires: 4 for track and road cycling, 2 for Mountain Bike and 2 for BMX.

The Mexican Cycling Federation will designate the Joint Commissaires for each of the specialties.

## PROTESTS AND APPEALS

No resource will be admitted against the minutes, the appreciation of the situations of the race and the application of the competition rules made by the Panel of Commissaires.

The decisions made by the Panel of Commissaires or the referee in terms of facts of the competition are without a resource, unless when there is a fine that exceeds 200 Euros, in this case the Technical Directors may present a resource to the disciplinary commission of the UCI which will have the last decision. The resource must be presented within ten days after the end of the event

## SPORTS EQUIPMENT

Every Technical Director must look after the quality of its equipment (bicycle with accessories, helmet, specialized equipment etc.) so as to not endanger themselves or others. Also, they need to guarantee that the equipment used in the competition either track or road is certified by UCI and complies with the regulations in place.



## QUALIFICATION TO TORONTO 2015

This sport will grant slots for the XVII Pan American Games Toronto 2015 to the champions of individual events of those events that are part of the Pan American Games in Toronto and the Olympic Games in Rio de Janeiro.

## MEDAL CEREMONIES

Medal ceremonies will take place according to CACSO General Regulations, Chapter XIII.

### Individual Events:

- First place: Gold medal and diploma
- Second place: Silver medal and diploma
- Third place: Bronze medal and diploma

### Team Events:

- First place: A diploma for the team and a gold medal and diploma for each athlete
- Second place: A diploma for the team and a silver medal and diploma for each athlete
- Third place: A diploma for the team and a bronze medal and diploma for each athlete



## COMPETITION VENUES

The Cycling competitions will take place in:

- Track – Xalapa Velodrome - Carretera Xalapa - Coatepec S/N, Xalapa
- BMX - BMX Xalapa – next to Xalapa Velodrome - Carretera Xalapa -Coatepec S/N, Xalapa, Veracruz
- Mountain – Xalapa Mountain Circuit
- Road – circuit to be defined
