MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

According to the established quota by CACSO the Water Polo competition will have a maximum of **a hundred and eighty two (182)** athletes. According to the FINA Water Polo Regulation 5.1, each team will be formed by thirteen (13) members.

Teams: Women: Six (6) teams x thirteen (13) athletes = seventy eight (78) female athletes. Men: Eight (8) teams x thirteen (13) athletes = a hundred and four (104) male athletes.

Each NOC may enter one (1) team per gender as long as they meet the qualifying system established by CCCAN for the XXII Central American and Caribbean Games, Veracruz 2014.

VERACRUZ 2014 QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

Women: Six (6) teams will qualify to the XXII Central American and Caribbean Games, Veracruz 2014 as follows:

- a) Mexico is automatically qualified as host country.
- b) The five (5) remaining teams will be the teams located from the 1st to the 5th place excluding Mexico in the 2013 CCCAN Championship to be held at San Jose, Costa Rica on July 3-7, 2013.

Men: Eight (8) teams will qualify to the XXII Central American and Caribbean Games, Veracruz 2014 as follows:

- a) Mexico is automatically qualified as host country.
- b) The seven (7) remaining teams will be the teams located from the 1st to the 7th place excluding Mexico in the 2013 CCCAN Championship with place and date to be defined.



If a team resigns the obtained slot, CCCAN reserves the right to analyze the case to determine the team that will replace it, in agreement with CACSO.

Qualifying system approval

CCCAN revised and approved this qualifying system on August 26th, 2012.

TECHNICAL MEETING

- The Technical Meeting will take place on **Friday November 21st, 2014** at the Central American and Caribbean Village in Veracruz at a time to be confirmed.
- The invitation card for the Technical Meeting will be available to the Heads of Team at the Sports Information Center at the Central American and Caribbean Village upon their arrival.
- The Technical Delegate and the Organizing Committee's Competition Manager for Water Polo will preside the meeting, which shall take place in Spanish with simultaneous translation to English.

TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

For Water Polo, the technical officials shall be:

- a. Eighteen (18) International Referees from the present FINA List
- b. Five (5) CCCAN TWPC Delegates
- c. One (1) CCCAN Executive Liaison
- d. One (1) FINA Representative

PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Protests may be made to the Referee in accordance with FINA Rule GR 9.2.

The Representative of FINA and the Executive Committee of the CCCAN will constitute the Jury of Appeal for the technical issues. The Jury of Appeal will receive and resolve all appeals submitted to it in accordance with FINA Rule GR 9.3.

DRAW

Draw will take place during the Technical Meeting and will be made by the Water Polo Technical Committee.

SPORTS EQUIPMENT

The official ball is Molten Mikasa 6000 for Men and Mikasa 6009 for Women.

QUALIFICATION TO TORONTO 2015

The top three (3) teams of the Water Polo competition at the XXII Central American and Caribbean Games, Veracruz 2014 will qualify for the XVII Pan American Games Toronto 2015.



MEDAL CEREMONIES

Medal ceremonies will take place according to CACSO General Regulations, Chapter XIII.

Team Events:

- First place: A diploma for the team and a gold medal and diploma for each athlete
- Second place: A diploma for the team and a silver medal and diploma for each athlete
- Third place: A diploma for the team and a bronze medal and diploma for each athlete
