COMPETITION FORMAT

a) Every weight division begins and ends on the same day. The weigh-in for each category takes place the day before that division's competition.

The competition will develop as follows:

- Qualification rounds and repechage
- Finals

If there were less than 6 wrestlers in a division, the Round Robin competition system will be applied (all athletes fight each other).

b) At the end of the segment, wrestlers are grouped in pairs to find the ideal number. Repechages will begin with the athlete who lost the first round competing against one of the finalists and so on up to the losers of the semifinals, in direct order.

c) The victors of the two final repechages will receive a bronze medal.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

According to the quota established by CACSO, the Wrestling competition will have a maximum of **168 athletes**, 56 women and 112 men.

Each NOC may enter a maximum of 21 athletes, a maximum of 7 per style, as long as they have qualified according to the qualification criteria for Wrestling at the XXII Central American and Caribbean Games, Veracruz 2104.

Only 1 athlete per country may participate in each weight category.



COMPETITORS' AGES

Competitors must be at least 20 years old by December 31st, 2014 (born in 1994); athletes who turn 18 years old during 2014 (born in 1996) may also participate if they present a medical certificate and parental authorization.

VERACRUZ 2014 QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

a) The Central American and Caribbean Championship of Associated Wrestling Styles 2014 will be a selective event for Veracruz 2014. It will take place in the city of San Juan, in Puerto Rico, April 2nd to 7th, 2014.

b) The host country (Mexico) qualifies directly, but it is mandatory that it participates in the selective event.

c) Based on the aforementioned points, the athletes who place in the top 8 slots for each style and weight category at the qualification event will qualify for the Central American and Caribbean Games, Veracruz 2014. If a Mexican athlete were to not qualify, the country that earned the eighth slot will have to yield their place to the host country.

d) Slots earned are for the country, not necessarily for the winning athlete.

e) If any of the following situations were to happen:

- That a qualified athlete cannot participate due to sanction, injury, etc.
- That an NOC chooses not to enter an athlete (or athletes).
- That the qualified athlete is sanctioned for doping, or any



other cause, the following criteria will apply:

1. The country that has qualified immediately beneath (9th, 10th, 11th, etc.) will occupy the available slot.
2. If there were no other qualified countries, FILA, through CPLA may grant a “wild card” to another country so as to complete the athlete quota approved by CACSO.

f) The associated Wrestling National Federations must send confirmation, in writing, to CPLA of the slots that will be occupied no later than **July 15th, 2014**. If the aforementioned issues were to arise, CPLA will inform the Organizing Committee of the substitute countries no later than **July 30th, 2014** so that the NOCs will be able to comply with the CACSO established dates for entry by name and number.

Qualification system approval

This qualification system was approved by FILA and CPLA in August 2012.

TECHNICAL MEETING

- The Technical Meeting will take place **Monday, November 24th, 2014** at the World Trade Center at a time to be confirmed.
- Up to two representatives from each NOC will be able to assist this Technical Meeting.



- The invitation card for the Technical Meeting will be available to the Heads of Team at the Sports Information Center at the Central American and Caribbean Village in Veracruz upon their arrival.
- The Technical Delegate and the Organizing Committee's Competition Manager for Wrestling will preside the meeting, which shall take place in Spanish and be translated to English.

TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

Technical official designation will proceed as follows:

- The 2 Technical Delegates and the 2 referee instructors will be designated by FILA at the beginning of 2104.
- Judges and Officials are designated by each national federation through their respective NOCs.
- Technical Support Personnel will be designated by the Mexican Federation of Associated Wrestling.

The FILA clinic for judges and referees will take place on Monday, November 24th, at 9:00 am at the World Trade Center.

DRAW

Drawing for the competition will take place during official weigh-in, the day before the competition as per article 12 of the International Competition Regulations.



PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Appeals shall take place according to article 34 of FILA's International Competition Regulations.

Coaches and athletes have the right to request revision of a determined action which will immediately take place on the monitors at the competition venue.

QUALIFICATION TO TORONTO 2015

All wrestlers that earn a gold medal in each style and weight category will qualify to the Pan American Games, Toronto 2015.

If a winning country has already qualified at the South American Games, Santiago 2014 or at the Pan American Olympic Festival, the qualification will be given to the closest-scoring country in descending order.

MEDAL CEREMONIES

Medal ceremonies will take place according to CACSO General Regulations, Chapter XIII.

- First place: Gold medal and diploma
- Second place: Silver medal and diploma
- Third place: Bronze medal and diploma (2)

COMPETITION VENUE

The Wrestling competition will take place at World Trade Center, which is located at Boulevard Adolfo Ruiz Cortines #3947, Boca del Rio, Ver.
